***General Fund:** Day to day operations, half paid by camp fees and half by donations from churches and individuals.

***Building Fund:** This is for big projects like the new dining hall (phase II of the Retreat Center). Current balance is \$150,579.00 and the plan is to start building when we have \$500,000.



Missionary Update

What do 2 children's homes built (and more in the near future), kids grown and impassioned in their faith, a children's ministry blessed, and multiple amazing experiences serving alongside gifted ministers and volunteers all have in common? White Mills Christian Camp

As a young children's minister at Shively Christian Church, I brought our church kids and my own children to camp while I served as faculty. As a minister and father, I knew that the kids in my ministry needed to have the concentrated Bible learning, fellowship, and confidence that White Mills offers. All my kids love White Mills Christian Camp and look forward to any summer we can be the missionaries there.

When I resigned from Shively to go into full-time missions, I desired to see my kids continue to attend camps at White Mills and I still wanted to serve on the faculty. God didn't disappoint! Since 2012 numerous weeks of camps have asked me to serve as their missionary. Since that time, the kids at White Mills have raised nearly \$20,000 for our mission, Child Help International! Today the Naeuwa Children's Home and Family exists in Samburu because of White Mills Christian Camp, which funded over 80% of the building! Ten orphans and a widow are daily given hope because of the ministry that was literally built by White Mills Christian Camp. This year nearly \$8,000 was raised to send my family to India and begin building two children's homes among the churches there!
