

Church Spotlight - Freedom Christian Church



The minister, Wendell Roberts, started as the first full time minister serving from 1979-1985 and 1993 till present. The church has grown in many ways especially in outreach. Missions giving is a priority and they also put muscle behind the gifts. This is evident at camp by the numerous gifts and work that the church men have provided the camp. Most recent, and the one pictured, is a group building a work shop addition onto the camp barn. Also, they help with Waves of Mercy, Northwest Haiti Christian mission as they build all their shipping crates and deliver them to Frankfort for Haiti Missions Hope Cafe'. Members of Russell county benefit as they help feed the needy. VBS remains a strong outreach program with an average attendance of 140.
