As the old dorm built in 1954 needed to come down for many reasons including safety we are already proactively making plans for a fourth new dorm. This new dorm will be enhanced by a covered deck with a view of the river, additional meeting space and enlarged bathroom areas that will be especially helpful to those with special needs.
