had 25 staff members who worked so hard every week keeping everyone fed, swimmers safe, the grounds neat, and the buildings clean. The new Retreat Center Dining Room was a huge success and campers enjoyed not just great food, but also music, mail call, wacky hijinks, & fun games during mealtime thanks to the stage and audio/visual system. Campers gave just over \$7,000 to several different missions over the summer and some campers even had the opportunity to serve out in the community.
