These are just a few of the main items accomplished here over that past 62 years. It is amazing to see the consistent growth in attendance and to realize that it has always been a well attended church camp. Praise God!

- 1949 Four weeks of camp held this first year...attendance 256
- 1954 First two dorms were built...attendance 336
- 1957 Cost to build first pool was \$3,590. Attendance 397
- 1965 Total attendance was 551 campers and 132 faculty
- 1966 Chapel was built. Camper attendance 621
- 1970 New swimming pool walls poured late in the year at a cost \$25,123.70. Camper attendance 708
- 1974 First full time manager, Chief Perkins was hired. Attendance 618
- 1980 745 camper attended
- 1981 888 campers attended
- 1983 Camp manager Ron Heller was hired. Contract approved for dining room addition at a cost of \$12,670.00. Camper attendance was 925
- 1986 891 campers attended. Classroom shelter built with \$25,000 donation by Hays family of Elizabethtown.
- 1987 Record year of 1001 campers. Canteen moved from inside hotel to the well house.
- 1990 Handi-camp week introduced. Garage/Maintenance building was built. Total camper attendance 1255
- 1993 1202 camper attended. The "Lyman Williams (Canteen) Pavilion" was built
- 1994 Attendance was 1193. Thurman property purchased (6 acres & house) and Founders Dorm built
- 1998 1290 campers attended. Alumni and Builders Dorms built.
- 2002 Ron completed 20 years as manager. Todd Murphy hired as camp manager. Attendance was 1312
- 2005 Ben Fulcher hired as manager. Attendance 1236
- 2006 Retreat Center (First phase) completed. Kelly Fulcher hired as secretary. New campfire area complete. 1160 campers attended
- 2010 1415 campers attended. New pool & bathhouse completed June 1st
