The Board of Directors have prayerfully decided to step out on faith and begin a new Capital Campaign for the construction of a new dining hall and kitchen. This new addition to the Retreat Center will help the Camp better provide for the needs of our growing camps. As you know, the past few years have brought us record numbers during summer camp, but did you know that we are also hosting other groups almost every weekend throughout the year? Our beloved hotel dining room can seat 150 people, which means that many weeks during the (continued)

summer, campers are eating in 2 shifts. The new dining facility will seat 300+ and will include a fireplace, staging area (for announcements, mail call etc.) and outdoor seating. Large windows allow the diners to enjoy a beautiful view of the Nolin River keeping God's creation at the forefront of Camp. In addition, the new kitchen will provide the space and appliances necessary to keep all those Campers and Faculty well-fed.

In the excitement of this new project, you may be wondering what will happen to the current kitchen and dining room in the hotel. We will keep the hotel kitchen and dining room completely operational which will allow us to host multiple groups in the off-season. This will be of great benefit to the many churches and youth groups that use the camp throughout the year.

The Board of Directors is asking for your help and support for this project which they would like to see completed in 3-5 years. The number one way you can help is to pray! Of course, financial help is also needed to make this project a reality.
